

ORDINANCE NO. 2009 – 07

**AN ORDINANCE INCREASING CEMETERY FEES AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Warsaw currently maintains a municipal cemetery;
and

WHEREAS, the Village of Warsaw finds it necessary to increase the costs for
perpetual care and closing costs to properly maintain the cemetery; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of
Warsaw, Coshocton County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. The fee for perpetual care for all cemetery grave spaces or portion
thereof shall be \$50.00 effective July 1, 2009. The fee for opening and closing of each
cemetery lot shall be \$550.00 effective July 1, 2009. The fee for opening and closing for
cremated remains shall be \$200.00 effective July 1, 2009.

Section 2. That Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, welfare and morals such
emergency arising because of the necessity of accomplishing the paving timely and in an
expeditious manner; wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from
and after its passage and approval by the Mayor
