

ORDINANCE 2009-10

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE SHERIFF OF COSHOCTON COUNTY FOR POLICE PROTECTION FOR THE VILLAGE OF WARSAW AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Warsaw entered into a contract with the Sheriff of Coshocton County to provide police protection for the residents of the Village pursuant to an agreement signed March 31, 2001 and subsequently renewed.

WHEREAS, said agreement will expired by its term on December 31, 2009 and needs to be renewed;

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to continue the current contract between the Coshocton County Sheriff and the Village of Warsaw to provide protection under the terms of the attached agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Warsaw, Coshocton County, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to sign and execute the a attached agreement with the Coshocton County Sheriff to provide police protection for the Village of Warsaw.

SECTION 2. That the effective date of the temporary and provisional agreement is January 1, 2010.

SECTION 3. That Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety , welfare and morals.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
