

ORDINANCE 2009-13

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AND EXECUTE A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH THE WALHONDING VALLEY HISTORICAL SOCIETY, INC. AND DECLAIRING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Warsaw has leased space to the Walhonding Valley Historical Society, Inc, for a number of years and believes that it is in the publics best interest to continue leasing space to the Walhonding Valley Historical Society, Inc;

WHEREAS, the said agreement expired by its term November 1, 2008 and needs to be renewed:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Warsaw, Coshocotn County, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to sign and execute a certain Lease Agreement to provide rental space to the Walhonding Valley Historical Society, Inc. on behalf of the Village of Warsaw, Coshocotn County, Ohio. A copy of said agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein reference. Notwithstanding anything in the original contract lease agreement to the contrary, the lease term shall renew for a term commencing November 1, 2008 through December 31, 2010.

SECTION 2. That Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for preservation of the public peace, health ,safety, welfare and morals.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
