

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-04

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AND EXECUTE A CERTAIN WATER RESERVOIR GROUNDS LEASE AGREEMENT WITH THE COSHOCTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Warsaw is currently the owner of a certain water reservoir and the real estate upon which it stands; and

WHEREAS, the Coshocton County Board of Commissioners wants to place certain communications equipment upon the grounds of the water reservoir of the Village for internet communication purposes; and

WHEREAS, it is soundly in the public interest for the Village to cooperate with the Coshocton County Board of Commissioners to insure that high speed internet services are made available throughout the county; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Warsaw, Coshocton County, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to execute the attached Waster Reservoir Grounds Lease Agreement.

SECTION 2. That Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, welfare, and morals.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
