

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-07

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN A CERTAIN AMENDMENT TO GOVERNMENT AGGREGATION PROGRAM AGREEMENT DATED JANUARY 20, 2010 (“GAPA”) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on January 20, 2010, the Village of Warsaw executed a certain Governmental Aggregation Program Agreement (“GAPA”) with Volunteer Energy Services, Inc. (“VESI”); and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Warsaw believes that the Governmental Aggregation Program Agreement should be amended as outlined in the attached “Amendment Agreement” and renewed as to all other terms contained in the original agreement and is in the best interest of the citizens of the Village of Warsaw.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Warsaw, Coshocton County, Ohio, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Amendment Agreement attached on Exhibit “A” hereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, welfare, and morals, such emergency arising because of the need to complete approval timely; wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
