

RESOLUTION 07-2009

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING CERTIFICATION BY THE COUNTY AUDITOR FOR REPLACEMENT OF A CERTAIN 1.5 MILLS TAX LEVY WHICH IS SET TO EXPIRE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation is insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Village of Warsaw, County of Coshocton, State of Ohio, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Council of the Village of Warsaw, County of Coshocton, State of Ohio, desires to replace a certain 1.5 mills levy for street improvements which is about to expire, for the purpose of providing funds for the construction, reconstruction, resurfacing, and repair of streets, roads, and bridges pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code 5705.19 (G), upon the ballot for the general election to be held November 3, 2009; therefore be it further

RESOLVED, by the Council of the above said taxing district, Coshocton County, Ohio, two thirds of all members elected thereto concurring that the County Auditor certify the amount of the levy; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Fiscal Officer of the above said taxing district be and is hereby directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Coshocton County Auditor, Coshocton County, Ohio as required by law for the November 3, 2009 General Election.

WHEREAS, under ORC 5705.03 (B) the Auditor is required to supply this tax district with the current tax evaluation certification within 10 days after the taxing authority requests it. The number of mills required to generate a specified amount of revenue, or the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a specified number of mills.

This resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure and shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law for the immediate preservation of peace, health, and safety of the Village of Warsaw.
